Instruction Manual

First, Check Your Phone

First, check if your smartphone can run VR apps.

All iPhones can.

Android phones can only run VR apps if the phone has a gyro sensor.

To test an Android phone, install the app "EZE VR" from the Google Play store. This app will test your phone for VR capability.

If your phone fails this test, sorry, it's not able to run VR apps.

Second, Set Up Your Phone

Install and open the Google Cardboard app.



Follow the prompts in the app to set up your viewer. The app will prompt you to scan a QR code. This code is on the bottom of your VR Goggles and also here:

Third, Some Tips

The touchpad must touch the phone screen or it won't work. Only touch the touchpad when you intend to. If it is not working try holding the phones edges with your other hand while tapping.

Touching the phone screen by mistake can cause you to exit your VR app.

Remove the protective cover from your phone while in VR. Check the phone is centered in the headset. Clean the lenses using a clean soft microfibre cloth and plain water.
